Moonacres produces certified organic vegetables for their own cafes and cooking school. They also supply top restaurants.

REQUIREMENTS

The Client engaged QuantumNRG to manage the farm's transition to renewable energy.

The key Client requirements were:

- Consolidate multiple farm metering points.
- Solution planning, design and integration.
- A development pathway.
- Minimise grid usage.
- Retire diesel generator.
- Sell excess solar to cafe.

SOLUTION

82 kW solar, 120kWh Redflow battery and VEN.

BUDGET


Total project budget, including project management: \$350k (ex GST).

- Single farm metering point.
- Solution integrated.
- Development consent achieved.
- 10% grid use.
- Full backup no diesel generator.
- Reporting real time energy data.
- Selling excess solar to cafe.
